



# Did you know?

Did you know the world's first Ford Mustang owner was a woman? Yep, the first-ever owner of a Ford Mustang was a 22-year-old Chicago schoolteacher who traded in a \$400 Chevy and borrowed the rest of



the money to cover the \$3,419 MSRP on an egg-shell blue convertible. According to Ford documents, Brown bought the car from Johnson Ford on April 15th, two days before it was set to go on sale nationwide. She said that when she balked at what the salesman offered from the showroom floor, he told her he had "something in the back that's really new"— a new 1965 Ford Mustang Convertible in Skylight Blue with a 260-cubic inch V8, automatic transmission, power steering, power top, knock-off wheel covers, center console and Rally Pac instrumentation. The lady was sold.

"I was the coolest teacher in the school that year," said Gail Brown, who had been cruising around in her parents' 1957 Ford Fairlane 500 convertible before making the purchase. Who knew!

With the brothers all living so close, we would get together every Sunday at Mom & Dad's for a few hours to chat. After a few years together I started bring a


different desserts to try-some good, some so-so. Great times!


# Morning Mistakes That Slow Down Metabolism

Metabolic rate is affected by several factors including age, weight, and genetics. Although there's not a whole lot you can do about those things, there are still choices that can cause metabolism to fire up or fizzle. If losing weight is your goal, avoid these metabolism-slowing mistakes in the morning.

Eating too late: Skipping breakfast is one of the worst things you can do for weight loss since it causes your metabolism to slow down. Eating within an hour of waking sparks the metabolic process called thermogenesis that turns the food you eat into energy.

Not exercising: Research shows you continue burning calories up to 24 hours after working out, and studies also show that morning exercises burn more calories than those who sweat it out during other times of the day.

Not pumping iron: Lean muscle mass burns calories, and just adding 5 to 10 pounds of lean muscle to your frame will increase your daily calorie burn by 100 calories.

#### **HEALTHY PUMPKIN PIE**

#### **Ingredients:**

2 cups prepared pumpkin

½ cup honey

4 egg whites

I ½ teaspoons cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon ground ginger

1/4 teaspoon ground cloves

I ½ cups fat-free milk (you can substitute unsweetened soy, almond or rice milk)

#### **Directions:**

Combine all ingredients in a large mixing bowl and mix thoroughly.

Pour mixture into whole wheat pie crusts

Bake at 425°F for 15 minutes.

Reduce oven temperature to 350°F and bake for 45 additional minutes.

**Side Notes:** This pie is not very sweet. If you prefer a sweeter pie, add an additional 1/4 cup of honey. Makes 2 traditional sized pies.


